





Xbox acquires Activision Blizzard for over \$68 billion Even amidst a lawsuit from the state of California, Activision Blizzard joins the Xbox team

On July 20, 2021, the world learned about the horrible events that took place in the Activision Blizzard company. Over 2 years of investigation from the state of California led to one of the biggest lawsuits the gaming industry has ever seen. Everyone saw this as the downfall of one of the most storied and hated companies in the industry. But on January 18, 2022, Microsoft stepped in and bought Activision Blizzard for over \$68 BILLION. Just last year, Xbox purchased Zenimax, the parent company of Bethesda, for \$7.5 billion. But people wonder why Xbox is purchasing Activision Blizzard, especially after the details of the lawsuit and the failure of Call of Duty: Vanguard and other Activision Blizzard games that have not done so well or have been constantly delayed. And, more importantly, how will this affect you and you playing your favorite games?

The main game that Activision has been focusing on recently is Call of Duty, which is the highest-selling FPS franchise of all time. It's been their main cash cow and Activision has been giving it the most attention out of all their other games. COD fans are optimistic about this deal because it may finally get COD off its annual cycle of games. Every year, one of the three COD developers (Treyarch, Raven Software, and Sledgehammer Games) puts out a new COD game, regardless of how well or poorly the last game did. The most recent game, Call of Duty: Vanguard, was met with negative reviews but was still the highest selling game of December 2021. The second part of Activision Blizzard, Blizzard Entertainment is struggling. Even before the workplace lawsuit, Blizzard wasn't doing too well, Overwatch was on a heavy decline and World of Warcraft was doing worse than ever before, with other MMO games like Final Fantasy XIV (14) and New World snatching up all of WoW's player base. The lawsuit only worsened that. So why would Xbox go all-in on Activision Blizzard? Well, Xbox hopes to not only change the workplace in the Activision Blizzard offices, but they also want to add to Xbox Game Pass, which is without a doubt, the greatest deal in gaming at the moment. Xbox is planning to most games that their developers make to Game Pass, which has been their approach for the past 2 years or so.

Xbox has recently stated that they don't plan to make any current games Xbox exclusives, but future games are a different story. With rumors of the Elder Scrolls 6 being an Xbox exclusive, Xbox is filled with games and developers at their disposal. But people have been wondering, will Xbox do anything with Activision Blizzard? Xbox is notorious for buying out well-known game studios, and not utilizing them or their franchises as buying points for the console. However, now with Bethesda and Activision Blizzard under their belt, Xbox seems like a serious contender for the next following years to come.







Debate This!





